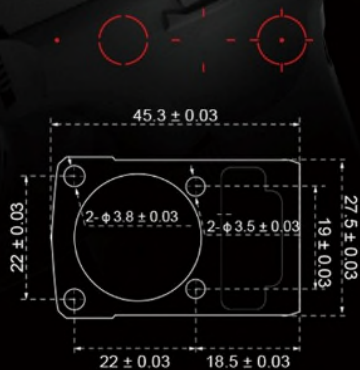


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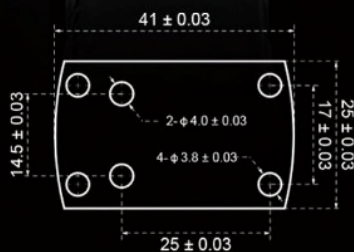

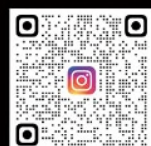

The Opening Ceremony of the 2026 PanAm Handgun Championship will be held at **Plaza Betico Croes**, in Oranjestad.

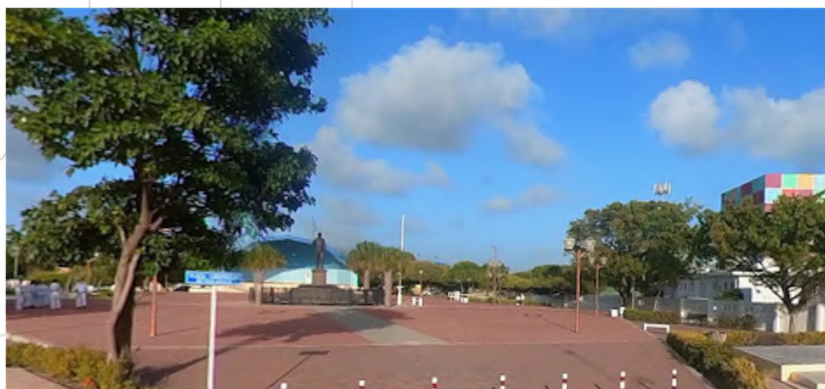
This formal gathering marks the official commencement of the championship and follows established IPSC ceremonial protocol.

- Safe areas will be designated
- No handling of ammunition in safe areas
- Competitors must wear eye and ear protection
- Scored hits are the highest two rounds per target; steel must fall.
- Timing will be by electronic timer, last shot stops the clock
- Penalty targets will be white
- Steel will be painted blue

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Firearm Logistics & Security Guide



Competitors traveling to Aruba must comply with the mandatory firearm handling procedures established by Aruba's law enforcement authorities.

Under local regulations, competition firearms may not be taken to any residential location, hotel, or other accommodation. Upon arrival at the airport, all firearms must be declared at Customs, tagged, and immediately surrendered to the designated Pan American Championship officials.

After landing, competitors will be guided to the official firearms processing area, where authorities will secure all firearms for the duration of the stay. Firearms will only be released for approved match activities and strictly in accordance with the Pan American Championship protocols on competition days.



Arrival & Secure Transport



Crucial Registration Data

Ensure arrival date and time are accurately reported for the airport greeting team.



Private Customs Clearance

Competitors are escorted to a private area for immediate firearm and customs processing.



Armored Truck Transfer

Firearms are moved via armored truck to a secure, off-site storage location.

Daily Range Procedures



Range-Only Gun Storage

Firearms must remain at the range; transport to hotels is strictly prohibited.

Daily Pick-up & Return



Morning

Collect guns every morning



Evening

...and return them to the designated location after shooting.



On-Site Ammo Distribution

All ammunition will be distributed directly at the range.



Firearm Departure Procedures



Competitors traveling to Aruba must comply with the mandatory firearm handling procedures established by Aruba's law enforcement authorities.

On the day of departure, competition firearms will be transported to the airport and placed in the Aruba Customs secured storage area.

Competitors must arrive **4.5 hours before** their scheduled flight and report directly to the Customs Office at the airport for release of their firearms.

After collection, proceed to the airline's check-in counter to complete the standard check-in process with your firearm and luggage.



SECURE POST-MATCH STORAGE

Return your firearm to secure storage immediately after your final shooting stage.



TRANSFER TO AIRPORT CUSTOMS

On departure day, guns are moved to the Aruba Customs secured airport storage.

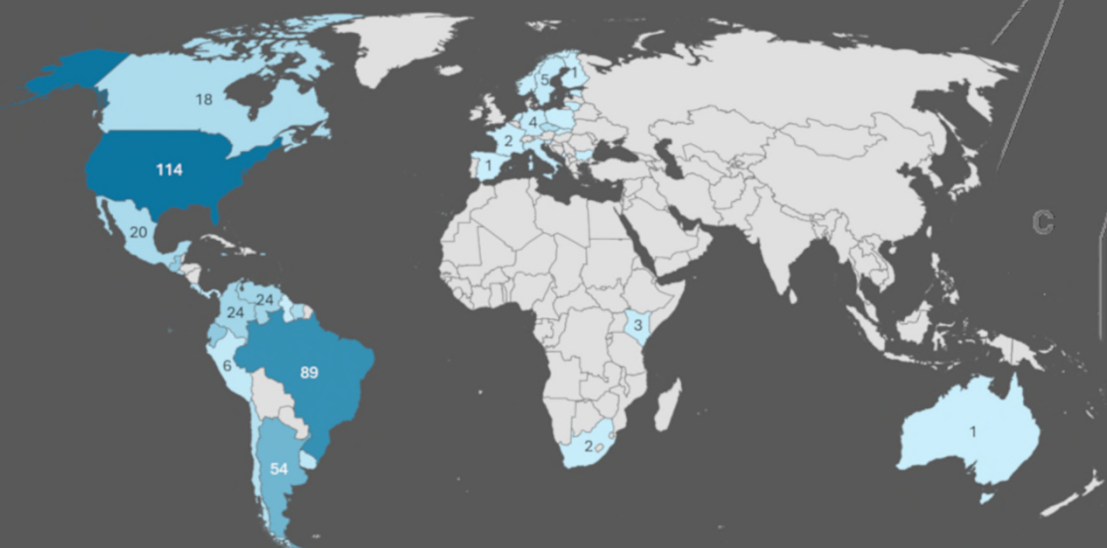

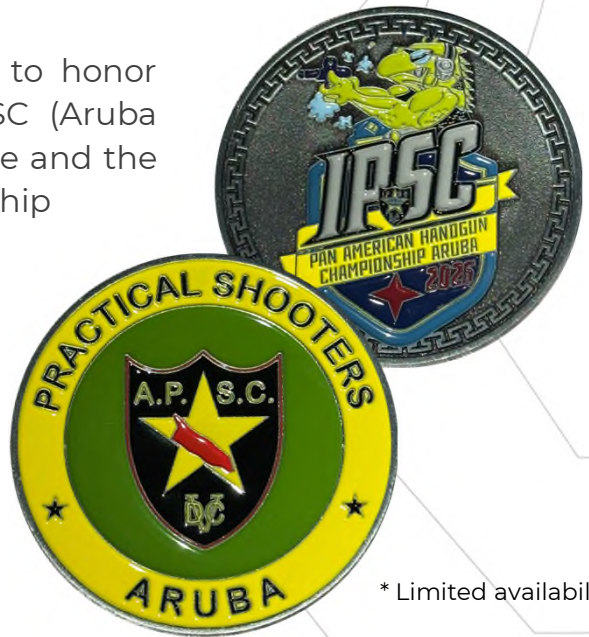




Commemorative coin

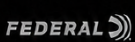

Club Jersey

This club jersey is a celebration of Aruba's nature, history, and cultural identity.

The blue pattern on the sleeves is inspired by Aruba's distinctive blue lizard, reflecting the island's unique wildlife and natural beauty. The iguana, which has long served as our club's mascot, was originally illustrated by talented local cartoonist Ron Wever, known for his work with the Aruban newspaper *Diario*. It represents our local character and the proud history of both our club and our island.

Across the yellow section, subtle patterns draw inspiration from the ancient pictographs attributed to the Caquetío people, an Indigenous group of the Arawak cultural and linguistic family. These pictographs can be found in the caves of Arikok National Park and offer an important connection to Aruba's ancestral heritage and earliest inhabitants.

Together, these elements make this more than just a competition jersey. They tell a distinctly Aruban story, allowing us to proudly carry the spirit, culture, and heritage of our island wherever we compete.
